
Making Photo Printing Easier with Epson EasyPrint

If you work with digital photos and print them for distribution to customers, business partners, family and friends, you already know how many steps it can take to get that photo printed on the right paper type, quality and size with the right print quality, font and scaling. Epson has decided to do something about this complexity by simplifying the photo printing process.

Epson recently announce their new EasyPrint technology which they hope, will soon part of many software applications. With EasyPrint, the most important print settings for Epson printers are embedded right into the application's print screen - you won't have to click on the "Properties" button and tab through all of the settings to get things right - most every setting you need will, instead, appear right on the initial print screen. Using EasyPrint you'll be able to select the right paper type and size as well as other settings.

One of the first applications to integrate EasyPrint technology is Adobe's Photoshop Elements 3.0. Epson Smart Panel 3.2 and Epson Copy Utility 3.0 also integrate EasyPrint right now. EasyPrint works in both Windows (98, ME, 2000, XP) and Macintosh (OS X 10.2 or later) environments and with Epson Stylus C64, C84, Photo 900, Photo 960, Photo 2200, Photo R200, Photo R300/R300M, Photo R320, Photo R800, Stylus CX 6400, CX 4600, CX 6600 and Photo RX500 printers.
